Receipt

On receipt of your subscription, the membership secretary will, by return, send you a receipt for your subscription, a membership card (more on that later) and your membership sticker.

Standing Orders

People with standing orders were asked in December 2002 to cancel them with immediate effect in preference of one of the other methods of payment. We would prefer if members signed up for the direct debit mandate, which is much easier for everybody to administer.

Payments to Branches direct

While this is not a preferred method, we appreciate that some people prefer to pay their subscription to a branch officer. Membership fees may be paid to any officer of your branch, who should issue you with a receipt.

Membership Card

A membership card is issued to each paid up member of the Association. The purpose of this is to distinguish paid up members versus lapsed members when it comes to availing of discounts negotiated by the membership services committee, (chandlery, insurance cover etc), and participating in IWAI events. This card will be posted to members when their subscription is received.
